We look forward to seeing you at Open House. Please enjoy the exhibits of our children's art in the auditorium, on hall boards and in classrooms.

Kindergarteners are working on cut paper self portraits using engineering skills to make their faces 3D.

1st graders are using their construction skills to create architectural models for dream houses inspired by the buildings in Dr Seuss books.

2nd graders are using their research on the continents of our earth and their paper engineering skills to finish a pop up 'brochure' showing the geographic features in 3-D. Coming soon: Medieval Arts!

3rd graders have been learning about ancient Greece. They designed beautiful Greek vases and urns. We are also working on creating puppets for their famous Massachusetts person. This is an interdisciplinary connection. The students are working their written presentation in their classroom and we are creating the visual presentation in art.

4th graders have begun experimenting with traditional Native American arts from several regions of North America.

5th graders are beginning a project on masks. The students will create a 3-D mask. They are currently working on various plans/sketches for the design on their actual mask.
