**\*IMPORTANT NOTE:** STUDENTS ENROLLED IN AP ECONOMICS AT HWRHS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE **BOTH** THE MACROECONOMICS AND MICROECONOMICS EXAMS.

Plan to arrive well before your exam's scheduled starting time.

### You SHOULD bring the following items to the exam:

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Pens, with black or dark blue ink only, for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- An acceptable calculator (/node/2551) if your AP Exam allows the use of a calculator.
- If you don't attend the school where you're taking the exam: a current government-issued or school-issued photo ID (Additional ID may be required by authorized test centers outside the United States.)
- Your College Board SSD Accommodations Letter if you are taking an exam with approved testing accommodations.

### You SHOULD NOT bring the following to the examination:

- Food or drink, including bottled water – these are not allowed in the exam room
- Any electronic equipment or communication devices, including:
  - Phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind
  - Laptops or tablet computers
  - Bluetooth devices
  - Portable listening or recording devices such as MP2 players and iPods
  - Cameras or other photographic equipment
  - Devices that can access the internet
  - Separate timers of any type
  - Any other electronic or communication devices

A student observed with any of these devices during testing or breaks may be dismissed from the exam, the device may be confiscated, the student's score may be canceled, and no retest may be permitted.

The AP Teacher will notify you when and where to report for the exams.

Most of the exams take two to three hours to complete. Most exams have a 10-minute break between Sections I and II. Additional time is required for things like completing identification information on the answer sheet, listening to exam instructions, and receiving and returning exam materials.

You are not permitted to bring food or drink, including bottled water, into the exam room (unless they have been approved as an accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office). During the 10-minute break between Sections I and II of the exam, you can leave the exam room to get a drink of water or a snack with your proctor's permission.

**Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended.** If you play a sport or have a job, it will be your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP obligation and arrangements should be made accordingly. Get a good night's rest before your test and eat a nutritious breakfast/lunch. You are allowed to bring a snack for your 10-minute break. However, eating is prohibited while you are taking an exam. You are required to abide by the policies of the both the College Board and Hamilton-Wenham Regional High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and has the potential to jeopardize your AP exam grade.
